Amy MacDonald is a Scottish singer-songwriter, guitarist, and recording artist, who released her debut album This Is the Life in 2007. The singles "Mr Rock & Rol"l and "This Is the Life" were taken from the album and went on to become chart hits; "This Is the Life" charted at number one in six countries, while also reaching the top ten in another eleven countries including the United Kingdom. Amy is still very actively engaged in music and will – no doubt – continue to impress for many years to come.

The intention on this recording was to hold on to the original style of presentation, as far as was possible, in a Square Dance format. The end result was a fast-moving style that really works well as a Square Dance tune - although Callers will need to work a little harder on this track. When recording the vocal, Cherish took the time to record it in both a "very fast" as well as a "fairly fast" style, to give Callers a choice. We sincerely hope that it will prove a popular tune to dancers of all ages!
