Reba McEntire is an American Country music singer, songwriter and actress, who has released 26 studio albums, acquired 40 number one singles, 14 number one albums, and 28 albums have been certified gold, platinum or multi-platinum in sales by the Recording Industry Association of America. She has sometimes been referred to as "The Queen of Country" and is one of the best-selling artists of all time, having sold more than 80 million records worldwide.

This is a true Gospel Country song that has been featured as an important part of Reba's performances for many years. It has a simple message that is easily conveyed by the musicians who deliver a great "rolling" Country feel. We have done all that we can to preserve this style and reproduce it here for Square Dancing. The fact is that we did not have to change things a great deal, to make this work, the music is almost exactly right for us; with just a little "re-structuring" we had all that we needed/wanted!!

Where a close-to-the-original sound is the "order of the day", Michael offers a slightly different way of producing music, on a "remote" basis - no need for us to make the trip to Nashville, allowing a little more opportunity for "experimentation" and "re-mixes" that will be necessary for these type of songs. This has expanded our range of styles to include almost everything!
